URI members work with communities in conflict in The Philippines

URI implements its mission through local and global initiatives in over 100 countries that build the capacity of its nearly 900 member groups, called Cooperation

Circles. These Cooperation Circles undertake community action projects on issues such as conflict resolution and reconciliation, economic development, education, environmental sustainability, human rights, women's empowerment, and youth leadership.

Supported by a global office in San Francisco and 21 regional offices on six continents, URI's decentralized, network-based approach to dealing with issues of poverty, conflict, and violence is giving people around the world the power to transform their struggles, and build cohesive, connected, and thriving communities.
