Programs Summary

In 2017, ICLDNG was able to organized programs that reached various communities .

Programs include:

- Safer Internet Day Awareness reached over 370 teenagers in Secondary School
- 52 Youth reached at the ICLDNG / IIGL Leadership Conference
- 47 Teenagers attended the August Summer Leadership workshop with two follow – ups, final follow-up project implementation and certification is January 16th, 2018
- Over 100 youth pledge for Peace in a campaign organized in commemoration of International Day of Peace.
- Over 300 Teenagers , Teachers, Youth, Journalists, corporate organizations and the Nigerian Police force attended the Cyber Security Awareness Month October, organized in collaboration with the U.S. Consulate Lagos, Port Harcourt and Abuja respectively

Leadership workshop continues to address the barriers students in high school face by providing this training at no cost, and covering topics such as Leadership / Self Awareness, Goal Setting / Goal Mapping, Career Path / Mentorship and Entrepreneurship, while also introducing participants to Internet Safety / Cyber Security Awareness, and how the Internet can be used for personal and societal advancement. SAFER INTERNET DAY AWARENESS

The International Centre for Leadership Development Nigeria (ICLDNG) in partnership with the Lagos State Government Ministry of Education District 1 celebrated the Safer Internet Day (SID) 2017 with the theme “ Be the Change, Unite for a Better Internet” at the Government Senior College Agege on the 7th of February 2017.



The event brought together parents, guardians, educators and students from different works of life. The aim of the event is to guide children and young people on how they can create a better internet by being kind and respectful online, protecting their online reputation, responding to negativities by being helpful bystanders, supporting their peers and develop a mutual co-existence with the online community.
